## Sokol Detroit UPC Meeting Minutes Highlights

July 15, 2016

Meeting called to order at 7:10pm. June 10 meeting notes and July 2 Special Meeting notes approved. Treasurer's report approved as read.

### Correspondence:

Kalivoda shed request approved. Motion to approve Jim Kalivoda's request to move dock space to another site (once site has been allocated) carried with 5 in favor, 2 opposed and 1 abstention. Jandasek shed request approved. Lawn Service at the Center will be contacted to remove weeds growing in shrubs along perimeter of property.

### Center Report:

Marquee-LED lights installed, new lettering board in place. Statue repairs complete (re-welded and repainted). Rocket Enterprises replacing flag pole ropes at cost of \$238. Parking lot repairs will not be completed in time for the festival.

### Camp Report:

Plaza soffit/fascia replacement material cost priced out at approximately \$1000, labor to be covered by volunteer crew. Enforcement of display of registration stickers on boats is the responsibility of the Sheriff but any member can individually approach a boat owner to see their registration and ask that it be displayed.

Vic Hurych has volunteered to build and donate a kayak rack for the Camp. Diagram of the proposed rack will be submitted at the August meeting and best placement of the rack will be discussed at that time.

New Business:

Bottomroo concert has been canceled. Discussion regarding moving the 2017 Festival to Camp will be discussed at the next Unit level meeting.

Dock Use Status – mid-July assessment of dock usage complete. Letters will be sent to dock owners not meeting criteria set forth earlier this season regarding usage.

Dock Waiting List – Discussion regarding when the proposed legacy dock assignments should be addressed relative to allocating the two new incremental dock spaces according to the waiting list. There is no current Camp rule addressing cottage owner dock assignments and if amended, new policy would not be in effect until October. As a result, the UPC will continue to apply the existing rules to dock space allocation.

Meeting adjourned at 9:37pm. Next meeting August 12 at 7:00pm at the Camp.
